will not be retried next month on charges that he raped a 16-year-old girl in her home in Meyers.

first trial in October ended in a hung jury after a day and a half of deliberations. At that time, a new trial date was set, but this month the El Dorado County District Attorney's Office said it would not be proceeding with the prosecution and the mistrial verdict would stand.

The district attorney's office could refile the case anytime in the next 10 years.
